Matthew 14:22-36

Subject: How can we get back to COMPLETELY trusting God through the storms of life?

#1 Fellowship gives a Firm Foundation

Courage is found where God is found vs 28 - "Lord, if it is you?"

#2 Failure reveals His Grace

Jesus let Peter sink - Because it produces Peter's cry - then Jesus catches Peter

- He won't let you fall He loves to hear you cry out to Him and save you
- God is not hindered to you by distance or your perception He can walk on the waves

#3 Faith Frees and Fear Focuses - Jesus says "fear not" - (doubt is evidence of a divided mind)

Out of Peter's comfort zone - he was used to the boat (fisherman) / safe from the waves / etc You won't walk on water unless you get out of the boat

Faith is not faith in our faith in Jesus, it is faith in the power of Jesus' word Obedience to "come" is the <u>evidence</u> of faith in Jesus' power Doubt is <u>evidence</u> of a divided mind

Jesus' promise/call is greater than our fears of the wind and waves

Walking on water means:

- facing your fears and choosing NOT to let fear control your destiny
- embracing the unique calling God has placed on your life
- watching the power of God to do that which you wouldn't be capable of doing on your own
