## The Mission of God: Part 2 - Incarnation

1 Corinthians 9:19-23

*"As the Father has sent me, I am sending you."*

- John 20:21

### Observations:

1. What does "win" mean? Answer: \_\_\_\_\_

3. Who and how? Answer: 3 Categories

Condition: Paul isn't under the law

### Conclusions:

1. Paul gave up his rights and comforts of freedom,
2. because he was motivated by his participation in the gospel of saving sinners from God's wrath,
3. that he might save some by being a willing servant to reach all.
