1 Timothy 6:11-16

### Observations:

1. Paul's summary command to Timothy is \_\_\_\_\_ fold
2. It is centered around "the \_\_\_\_\_" of "Jesus is Lord"
3. Paul rests his command on the doctrine of God's \_\_\_\_\_

**Definition** - \_\_\_\_\_: *God exists beyond, distinct from, and in all surpassing greatness from the creation*

1. - *God purposefully governs and directs everything*
2. - *God is atemporal, outside, and unrestricted by time*
3. - *God is the supreme authority; in control of creation*
4. - *God is singular in His being; without assembly*
5. - *God cannot die*
6. - *God is inaccessible in moral perfection and holiness*
7. - *God is mystery and unconstrained by human definition*
